FACT NO.

The Student Code of Conduct is an Alamo Colleges board policy that covers non-academic misconduct and academic integrity issues, and the disciplinary and appeal process.

FACT NO.

If you are found in violation of the Student Code of Conduct you could be removed from your class, referred to education enrichment workshops, put on probation, suspended or expelled.

FACT NO.

The Student Code of Conduct is supported by the Alamo Colleges Value of Respect for All.

FACT NO. If it's in your class syllabus it's a part of the Student Code of Conduct. If your instructor believes his/her advisement or classroom management as described in the class syllabus has not been effective you can be cited for Engaging in Disruptive or Threatening Behavior in the Classroom.

FACT NO. Did you know you agreed to follow the Student Code of Conduct and other rules just by applying to Palo Alto College?

> "The act of applying to be an Alamo Colleges student is an explicit acceptance of the Alamo Colleges' policies, procedures, regulations, and administrative rules."

The Student Code of Conduct disciplinary process is not intended to punish students, but rather to foster a learning environment of thoughtful study and discourse. to protect interests of the Alamo Colleges' community, and to challenge those whose behavior is not in accordance with the code.

The Alamo Colleges uses a unified system for reporting conduct violations, so you could be found in violation of the Student Code of Conduct at one campus and it could follow you to another.
